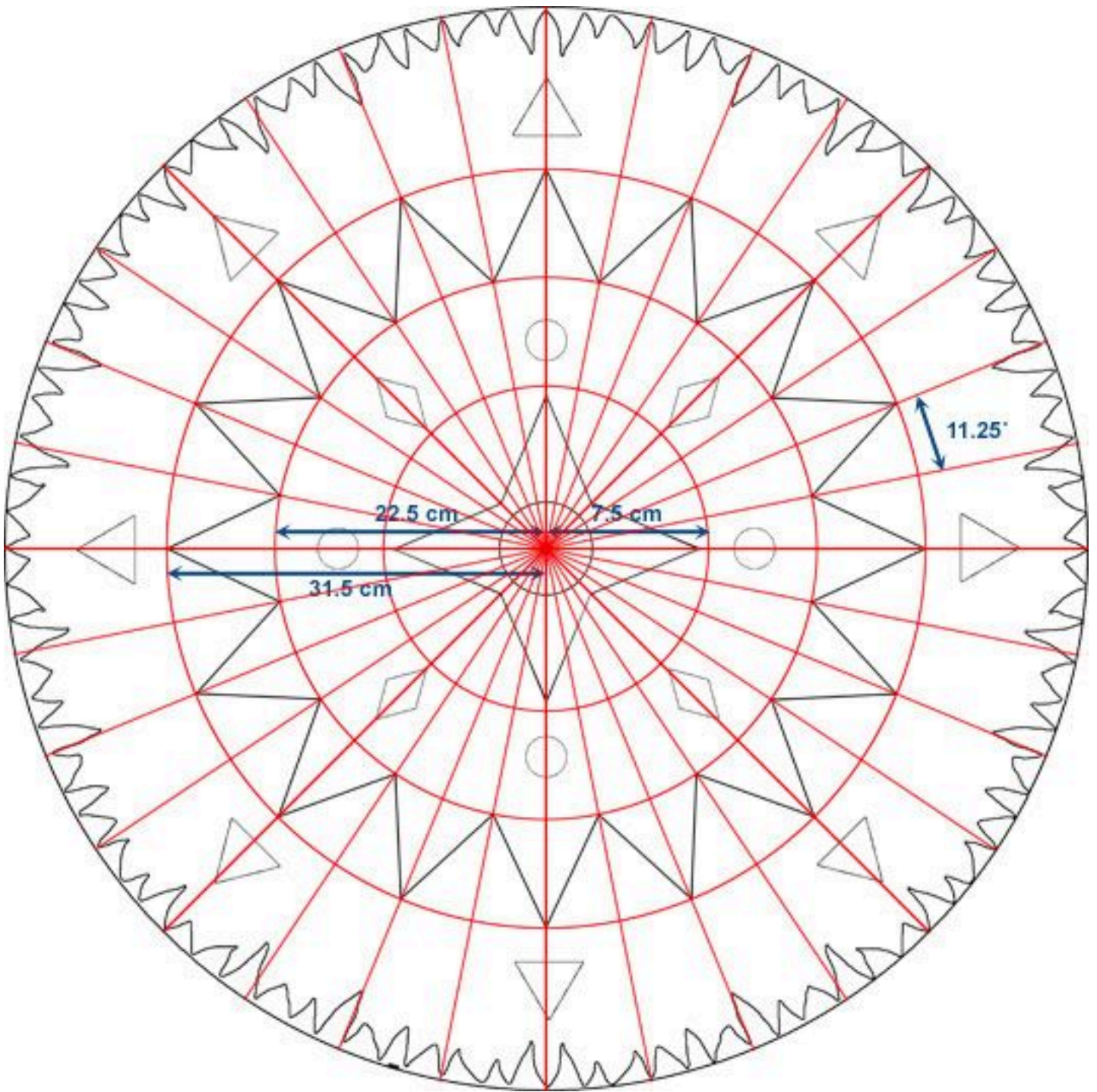
### Materials required

| Tiles    |           |     | Materials                                    |         |
|----------|-----------|-----|--|---------|
| Colour   | size (cm) | no. |  |         |
| Black    | 10 x10    | 29  | Tile Glue                                    | 4 kg    |
| Burgundy | 10 x10    | 10  | Tile grout                                   | 5 kg    |
| Red      | 10 x10    | 15  | Sealant                                      | 1 litre |
| Lemon    | 10 x10    | 7   | Plywood Base 15mm min. thickness, 90cm diam. |         |
| Orange   | 10 x10    | 11  | 4 x 16mm screws & wire                       |         |

### Tools

| Required   | Desirable                                 |
|--|---|
| Curved edge tile nippers                               | Both curved & straight edged tile nippers |
| Grouting tool (or use something from around the house) | Boat Grouter                              |

## Guidelines required for "Aztek" mosaic design.

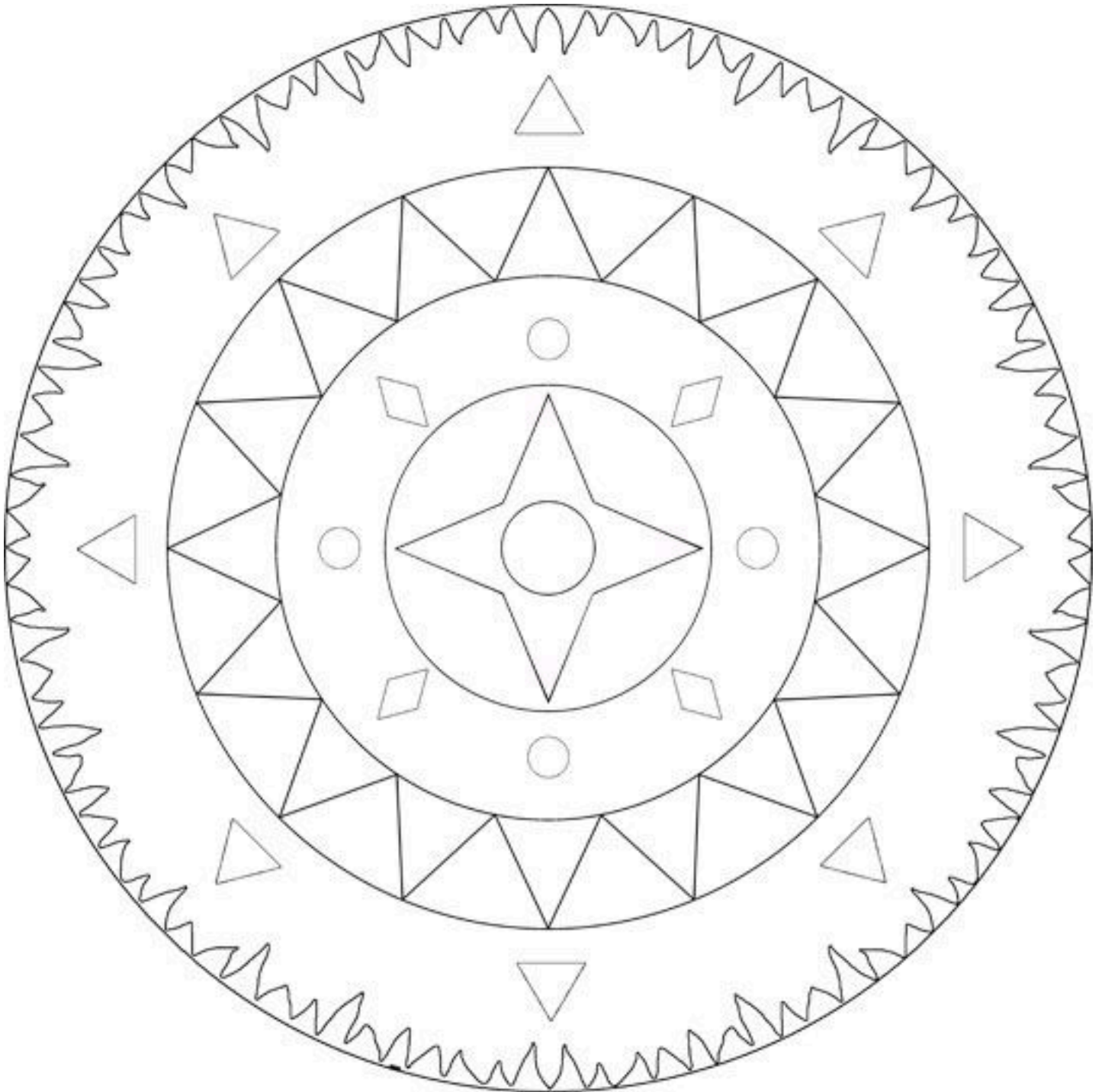


1. Draw red lines as shown with a ruler, protractor & compass.
2. Carefully transfer the drawing onto the board using the lines as a guide. Note where the black intersects the red
3. Trace over with a felt pen if you like.

## Alternative methods of transferring the design

The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.

You could also draw a grid on the design and a corresponding grid onto your backing board and draw the lines in yourself
